Before You Begin

- Clear the room of all debris and thoroughly clean the floors.
- Check with local building and code authorities about installation requirements specific to your location.



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


Install the Cabinet


Recommended Tools


- Two-foot Level
- Pencil
- Tape measure
- Hammer

72" (183 cm) From the Floor



1 At 72" from the floor, use a two-foot level and pencil to mark a line.






4 Approximately 24" away from the first setup hanger, use a level to position a second setup hanger in line vertically with the first hanger.

NOTE The distance between the setup hangers is approximate. If the second setup hanger is over a stud, you can move it to the left or right of the stud.


5 Hammer the second setup hanger into the wall.




CAUTION Be sure to complete all of the steps for installing the cabinet. Setup hangers are not intended to be the sole support of the cabinet.

6 Place the cabinet onto the setup hangers.

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7 Place a two-foot level inside the cabinet to check level.



8 To adjust level, insert U-shaped shims between the setup hanger and the cabinet stringer on the lower end of the cabinet.


Anchor the Cabinet

STOP READ THIS! A minimum of five anchors are required to secure the cabinet, four into drywall and one into a stud. Anchoring and structural needs may differ depending on the seismic requirements for the installation. Consult A-dec Customer Service for additional details.

Prepare a Hole to Anchor into a Stud

Recommended Tools

- Tape measure
- Pencil
- Stud finder



1 From inside the cabinet, locate a stud to use to anchor the cabinet.

CAUTION The hole for anchoring the cabinet needs to be a minimum of 1-1/2" (4 cm) down from the top of the cabinet to not interfere with the cabinet's fasteners.


2 Approximately 2"-3" (50 - 75 mm) down from the top of the cabinet, mark the location of the stud on the stringer.

Secure the Cabinet into a Wood Stud

Secure the Cabinet to a Stud

Recommended Tools


- Drill
- 1/4" drill bit
- 7/16" socket and ratchet




1 Use a 1/4" drill bit to drill a hole where you marked the stringer. Drill through the stringer, but not into the stud. Pre-drilling the stud is not required.




2 Install a flange washer on the 5/16 x 4" lag bolt.





3 Insert the lag bolt and washer through the hole then use a 7/16" socket and ratchet to lightly tighten the bolt until the sides of the cabinet touch the wall.



CAUTION

Install shims over the bolt securing the cabinet to a stud to prevent damage to the stringer when tightening the bolt.

- **4** Between the back of the cabinet and the wall, place U-shaped shims over the bolt until you fill the gap between the wall and stringer.


The gap between the stringer and NOTE the end of the cabinet's side is 1/4" (6 mm).

5 Use a 7/16" socket and ratchet to fully tighten the lag bolt.


Secure the Cabinet into a Metal Stud

Recommended Tools


- Drill
- 1/2" drill bit
- 7/16" socket and ratchet




Use a 1/2" drill bit to drill a hole through where you marked the stringer. Drill through the stringer and the metal stud.




- **2** Hold the metal catch of the toggle anchor flat against the plastic strap.
- **3** Push the catch fully through the hole in the wall and stud.



- **4** Pull the handle of the toggle anchor straight out.
- **5** Slide the plastic cap down the plastic strap until the cap is flush with the wall.





Wall and Metal Stud

CAUTION Install shims over the bolt securing the cabinet to a stud to prevent damage to the stringer when tightening the bolt.

10 Between the back of the cabinet and the wall, place U-shaped shims over the bolt until you fill the gap between the wall and stringer.

NOTE The gap between the stringer and the end of the cabinet's side is 1/4" (6 mm).

11 Use a 7/16" socket and ratchet to fully tighten the hex bolt.

Secure the Cabinet to the Wall

Depending on the cabinet's location, the four pre-drilled holes in the stringer may be in front of a stud or just the wall. Complete the instructions for each hole for what the fastener will secure into:


Secure the Cabinet to the Wall into Wood Studs

Recommended Tool

• 7/16" socket and ratchet



Flange Washer




2 Insert the lag bolt and washer through a pre-drilled hole and use a 7/16" socket and ratchet to fully tighten the bolt.

1 Install a flange washer on the

 $5/16 \times 4^{"}$ lag bolt.

3 Repeat steps 1-2 for each pre-drilled hole in the stringer.




4 Remove any shims used between the setup hangers and stringer to level the cabinet.


Secure the Cabinet to the Wall into Metal Studs or No Studs

Recommended Tools


- Drill
- 1/2" drill bit
- 7/16" socket and ratchet




1 Use a 1/2" drill bit through the 4 pre-drilled holes in the stringer to drill holes into the wall.



- **2** Hold the metal catch of the toggle anchor flat against the plastic strap.
- **3** Push the catch fully through the holes in the wall and stud.



- **4** Pull the handle of the toggle anchor straight out.
- **5** Slide the plastic cap down the plastic strap until the cap is flush with the wall.




Prepare the Cabinet

Route and Connect the LED Task Light


Recommended Tool

• Cable snake




1 Route the LED task light cable down through the wall and out of a hole in the bottom of the wall.

Install the Anchor Screw Caps



1 Install the caps over the anchor screws securing the cabinet to the wall.

Install the Doors



- **1** Insert the door hinge onto the front catch of the hinge mounting plates,
- **2** To lock the hinge in place, press the back of the hinge onto the hinge plate.


Adjust the Doors


Recommended Tool

• #2 Pozidriv[®] screwdriver


CAUTION To avoid damaging the screws, use a #2 Pozidriv[®] screwdriver to adjust the door hinge screws.


Side to Side





Up and Down









NOTE The screw on the hinge plate may be at the top or bottom, depending on the door.
